Registered under the Travancore-Cochin Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act 1955. (Reg. No. T.S.8/1961). Affiliated to the Akhil Bharatheeya Hindi Sanstha Sangh, New Delhi set up by the Ministry of Human Resources Development, Govt. of India. Established in the year 1934. It was on the call of Mahatma Gandhi, the erstwhile Travancore Hindi Prachar Sabha was established for the dissemination of Hindi. Recognized by Central Hindi Directorate, Govt. of India.

INFRASTRUCTURE :

Hindi Bhavan is housed in an area of 12000 sq.ft. six-storeyed building having 4 Sections - viz General Section, Examination Section, Sugama Section, Cash counter and account section, chambers of officers bearers, a committee room, a large auditorium with 350 seating capacity, Acharya Teachers' Training College with Principal's chamber, computer lab, counselling room, two guest rooms with A.C and TV facilities including 11 class rooms (two smart class rooms with LCD projectors and ICT facilities).

GOVERNANCE :

Governed by an Executive Committee comprised of 21 members, elected by the General Body. The head is the Secretary elected by the Executive Committee for a period of 5 years. Besides, a President, a Treasurer and two Vice Presidents are also elected by the Executive Committee.

The total duration of the courses from Hindi Pradhama to Sahithyacharya is 4½ years. Hindi Pradhama, Hindi Doosari and Rashtrabhasha (Hindi) are considered as Primary Courses, Hindi Pravesh, Hindi Bhooshan and Sahithyacharya have been declared as equivalent to Matriculation, Inter and B.A., respectively, by Govt. of India. Hindi Bhooshan has been recognised as a qualification for appointment as Hindi Teachers in U.P Schools of Kerala by the Govt. of Kerala and Public Service Commission. Sahithyacharya has been approved by the Universities in Kerala as III part of B.A Hindi and eligible for Higher studies. Govt. of India, Ministry of Education has approved Sahithyacharya as equal to B.A. Hindi.

NO. OF STUDENTS

Students to the tune of 30,000 participate in various Hindi examinations every year.

Courses organised through Pramanith Pracharakas (presently more than 8000) in Hindi Vidhyalas (presently more than 2000), Regional Offices and also by direct study in the Sabha. All examinations are conducted by the Sabha.

ACHARYA TEACHERS TRAINING COURSE :

Started in 1988. Duration: 2 years with 4 Semesters. Recognised by National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi

Approved by Govt. of Kerala as equivalent to B.Ed. for appointment of teachers in High schools and Higher Secondary Schools. University of Kerala has also approved the course as equivalent to B.Ed.



P.G. CENTRE

P.G. Diploma in Translation, Office Procedure and Journalism:

Well qualified and experienced hands viz. Head of the Departments (Retired), Professors (Retired) handle the PG Centre.

Duration : 1 year. Recognised by Govt. of India for appointment as Hindi Translators in Central Government Offices, Public Sector Banks and other organisations.

Private Study: BA Hindi and MA Hindi of University of Kerala.

Training for Typewriting, Shorthand and Word Processing at Headquarters and Regional Offices.

SUGAMA

Sugama Hindi Examination conducted for students of CBSE/ICSE/State syllabus every year for creating awareness in Hindi. Nearly 40,000 students in 600 schools under CBSE/ICSE and 4 lakh students in 2500 schools under State Syllabi participate. Rank holders in each district are presented with trophies in a grand function organised at district level.

Monthly Hindi magazine published since 1966 focusing the culture and literature of Kerala. Approved by the State Government for School/College Libraries. Included in the UGC Care List. Only magazine published in Hindi in the State.



PRINTING PRESS :

Rashtravani Mudranalaya - Works in Hindi, Sanskrit, Malayalam, Tamil and English are done here. Examination materials including question papers, text books, and magazines are got printed in this press.
